

FHTTC 2010 Winter Round Robin League Format

- Begins Tuesday January 26th and runs through Tuesday April 13 (12 weeks)
- Players will be grouped in round robin divisions according to ratings as follows:
 - Division 1 = 1901 and over Coordinator Ian Mailing
 - Division 2 = 1451-1900 Coordinator David Kleschik
 - Division 3 = 1450 and under Coordinator By appointment
- At the discretion of the league organizers the highest rated player in the room at 7:30pm may be invited to play up to make an even number in a higher division.
- Unrated players will be assigned a provisional rating and division by the organizers.
- Players arriving after 7:30pm will not be permitted to join in the round robin unless all players in the round robin agree to permit entry and there is ample time for the new entrant to complete all his games by 10pm (using 20 minutes per match as a basis) - no exceptions.
- Anyone who does not complete their round robin or who fails to fill in his game results on the score sheet shall not be permitted to play in the next round robin.
- If four players or less enter the round robin the format will be double round robin.
- If eight players or more enter, the round robin will be split into two groups (seeded by rating) and the first in each RR group plays the second in the other (semis) and then the two winners play (finals).
- Four tables will be reserved for each group with adjustments based on entries.
- League play will take precedence -- open play only if extra tables are available.
- Division winners will be noted and recognized on the wall of the club each week.
- Winners of divisions 2, and 3, may elect the option of moving up to the higher group the next week only with proof of victory (i.e. draw sheet or wall chart).
- League division winners will have the most 1st place finishes over the 12 weeks. In the case of a tie, the most second place finishes will determine the winner.
- Any dispute or rule clarification shall be settled by David Kleschik.
